The Social Services Office helps people who have social or economic problems. It works to help citizens and to promote inclusion and equal opportunities. The office works with local associations, schools, and health centers to organize activities for families, elderly people, and people with disabilities. These activities help to create a stronger and more caring community where everyone feels accepted and supported.

TRACCIA 2

Social services help elderly people in many ways. They can provide home care, medicine, and meals. Social workers visit aged people to see if they are safe and healthy. Social services also organize activities so elderly people can meet others. They also support people with disabilities, they help them find work, school, and medical care. Social workers give advice and support to families. People with disabilities can use special transport and centers.
